- 1. Tune your ukulele each time you use it.
- 2. Keep your uke where you live, ie., next to the recliner? In the kitchen?
- 3. Learn one chord at a time (front cover): C, Am, F, G7, G6, E7, A7, A, D, Dm, Em,...
- 4. As you learn each new chord, practice moving back and forth from one to another.
- 5. Pick a melody you know and practice its chord progression (pages 146-151).
- 6. Sing the song as you downstroke (\big) once for each chord.
- 7. Experiment with strumming patterns.
- 8. Experiment with picking patterns.

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
